You will facilitate a therapeutic support group for female survivors of rape and child sexual abuse. You will also be responsible for conducting assessment sessions for potential group members. You will have extensive experience of working therapeutically with survivors of rape and sexual abuse. You will also have at least 2 years experience, post qualification, of running therapeutic groups.

You will work with the WHWC staff team to fulfil specific monitoring requirements, ie assessment forms, weekly register, six monthly progress review, and end of year report on the running of the group.

You must be qualified to Post Graduate level, and ideally Masters level. You must be fully accredited by your professional body. You will have exceptional communication skills, demonstrate integrity and reliability, and work within professional ethical boundaries.
